Purpose of your role

To muck out stables, groom horses, clean tack. Excercise horses. Clean stables, toilets and volunteer/visitor area. Support other volunteers and visitors with special needs.

To skip out stables daily. Make up feeds and feed and water horses. Groom daily while checking for injuries and infections, give love and attention to all horses. When confident, excersice horses.
